

Study Guide: *A Lesson from a Doughnut Shop*

Based upon **John 13:12-17**

1. Three times in this passage Jesus indicates His disciples should do what He had just done to them. Vs. 14, "You \_\_\_\_\_ to wash one another's feet." Vs. 15, "You would do just as I did for you." And vs. 17, "You are blessed if you do them."
2. Concerning Jesus, John 1:3 says, "All things were made through Him, and without \_\_\_\_\_ nothing was made that was made" (NKJV).
3. "No one was so \_\_\_\_\_ as Christ, and yet He stooped to the \_\_\_\_\_ duty. That His people might not be misled by the selfishness which dwells in the natural heart, and which strengthens by self-serving, Christ Himself set the example of humility. He would not leave this great subject in man's charge. Of so much consequence did He regard it, that He Himself, One equal with God, acted as \_\_\_\_\_ to His disciples. While they were contending for the highest place, He to whom every knee shall bow, He whom the angels of glory count it honor to serve, bowed down to wash the feet of those who called Him Lord" (Ellen G. White, *Desire of Ages*, pg. 649).
4. Jesus calls us to humbly serve. He led by example. Let's \_\_\_\_\_ His lead.
5. We need to ask God to remove our \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_, so that we can humbly serve others.
6. Proverbs 29:23 says, "A person's pride will bring him low, But a \_\_\_\_\_ spirit will obtain honor" (NASB).
